

Keeping a Fuel Log

Smart thing to do for many reasons....

- Its impossible to remember how much fuel you burned on every journey
- You'll develop a better feel for estimating how much fuel you need on the fly
- You'll know exactly what you burned on similar trips

Do keep a fuel log with multiple columns including engine hours to track fuel usage
